


# WELCOME


#### A taste of the land




#### Thuline - paint, create, be inspired

# GOLF

It may not be a place that springs to mind when you think about golf, but the Lake District offers a truly stunning experience, combining beautiful courses with breathtaking natural scenery.

#### Windermere - 20 min drive

The 18-hole course features rolling landscapes, narrow fairways, rocky outcrops, and small USGA-spec greens, providing a fair challenge to golfers of all abilities.

#### Carus Green - 30 min drive

18-hole course featuring two-tier greens, strategic doglegs, and water hazards, including the meandering Rivers Kent, Mint, and Sprint.

#### Casterton - 45 min drive

The course comprises 2 par 3s, 6 par 4s, and 1 par 5 hole, each with unique characteristics that require thoughtful shot placement and course management.

#### Ulverston - 45 min drive

The 18-hole course features a variety of holes, including challenging par 3s and doglegs that require strategic shot placement. Notable holes include the 3rd, a 414-yard par 4 with a central mound, and the 17th, which presents a tough tee shot and approach.

#### Cockermouth - 45 min drive

The 18-hole course, with stunning vistas, features 13 par 4s, 4 par 3s, and 1 par 5 hole, with a variety of blind shots and undulating fairways that require strategic play.
